The soft foam cushion over the ear makes the Headset comfortable to wear for long periods of time. Further mechanical enhancements on the Wireless LINC™ Belt-Pac have significantly increased its durability. The new control buttons can withstand over a million activations. The robust coating on the belt-pac also protects it from melting, denting and staining.
